

## How Was Alumni Founded?

[Copy of Our Alumni is Formed by Mr. J. Fletcher]

September 4, 1955 was a happy day at the school. It dawned bright and sunny with a clear blue sky. The buildings were bright and shining too, as former pupils began gathering at 10 A.M. for registration.


About 10:45 Dr. MacDonald opened the meeting with an amusing and interesting speech of welcome. Miss Blake told of the happiness it gave to see so many present to form at last, an




alumni association. For several years many of us had talked about having a get-together and at last it had happened. Miss Blake wished the new club every success and hoped it would soon reach one hundred per cent membership. It is the first alumni association of the deaf in Canada and chalks up another first for the Jericho Hill School.

Discussion as to fees followed and it was decided to collect fifty cents a year from members. It was also decided to have an alumni news page in each copy of the Totem Pole. Then twenty-give cents would pay for the five copies of the Totem Pole and twenty-give cents would go to club fees. All paid—up

members would get the Totem Pole with the alumni news five times a year.



Dr. MacDonald was unanimously elected honorary president and Miss Blake an honorary member. The election of officers resulted in Bob Barr being president, Peggy Brooker, vice-president and John Fletcher, secretary-treasurer.



At 12:15 group pictures were taken on the steps of Dr. MacDonald's residence and Mrs. MacDonald took colored movies as the group moved into lunch.

The buffet luncheon attractively arranged by Miss M. Donald and Miss Forrest, Assistant Nurse-Matron, was thoroughly enjoyed. Mrs. Tyler said the grace as she used to do years ago.

The following special guests were welcomed by all at the luncheon – Mrs. S.H. Lawrence, Mrs. Clarke of the Quota Club, Mr. and Mrs. E. Bond, Mr. and Mrs. A. E. Withers, Mr. and Mrs. T. Westman and Mrs. Molvillo (Miss Planta).

As everyone was enjoying the ice-cream and delicious "Welcome Alumni" cake, Dr. MacDonald announced that Mr. and Mrs. Joe Fea had won the prize for the ones who had come the farthest. They had come from Spokane, Washington, U.S.A. Miss Millie Harrison won the other prize for the one who had left school the farthest back. They were surprise packages.

Peggy Brooker thanked Dr. MacDonald for giving the alumni the freedom of the school and also thanked Miss Blake and the committee for arranging the get-together and this officially closed the gathering

Most of the members had a tour of the grounds to view the new building and others were very much interested in a large book of photographs showing some of them as small children. It had pictures from 1919 to 1955.

About 4 P.M. we left for home having had a grand time and looking forward to another wonderful party next year. Be sure to come in 1956.


